Jurisdiction: All MCRCV Club Championship events are held in accordance with Motorcycling Australia G.C.R.s and MCRCV Club Championship rules. YOU MUST AQUAINT YOURSELF WITH THE CURRENT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES TO PARTICIPATE IN MCRCV EVENTS.

Riders can only compete if they hold a national or one day competition licence and must be a financial member of MCRCV or be a financial member of an invited participating club for that particular event.

Junior members can only compete if they have completed a current Junior Coaching Program.

All riders and workers must hold a current financial subscription to the Victorian Ambulance Service.

Format to be decided: Format and start times will be confirmed in the Final Instructions that will be posted on the MCRCV website 6 pm Friday the 17th February 2012.

All riders and Guardians must attend the riders briefing.

Entries

On-Line \$30.00 per rider

On Race Day \$50.00 per rider

One day Licence \$50.00

You must become a member before entering, Membership is available on line via the MCRCV website.

ENTER ON LINE via the MCRCV web site and must be received by entry close on Thursday 16th February 2012.

ONE DAY LICENCES - If you do not hold a current national MA racing licence you will have to purchase a one day licence. You will need to purchase this prior to lining up at sign in.

Members of invited participating clubs will have to enter on race day and will have to pay the late entry fee (\$50.00) which includes a day membership fee.

Sign In

All competitors must sign in prior to the event (Guardians must sign on behalf of an under 18 yo).

Current JCP Log books for all juniors must be presented at sign in.

A current national licence or a one day licence must be presented at sign in.

A current membership card or receipt of current membership must be presented at sign in.

Riders and/or their Guardians must check at sign in that the correct number is listed.

Rider Numbers

Riders can use their VORC number (preferred). If you don't have a VORC or a MV MX number, a club number will be allocated. MCRCV allocated numbers only will be available at sign in. All competitors must display three sets of legible numbers located on the front and both sides of the motor cycle. Electrical tape for numbers will not be accepted. Riders must not ride with a different number on their apparel than that on their motor cycle.

Scrutineering

All machines will be deemed safe by rider/entrant.

Riders must wear their protective riding gear at scrutineering.

Eligibility of numbers will be checked.

Noisy motorcycles may be excluded. Noise is probably the biggest threat to our sport and series. Do not turn up with a poorly maintained, after market or MX, noisy exhaust system.

It is up to the competitor to prove the noise level of their machine. The MCRCV reserves its right under the G.C.R.'s to reduce noise limits where necessary. **DO NOT BRING A NOISY BIKE!!!**

Classes

Seniors – all seniors' classes are all powers

A - A grade Motocrossers, Pro and Expert Enduro riders and graded riders.

B - B & C grade Motocrossers, Intermediate, established Clubman Enduro and graded riders.

C - All other Riders 18 – U35yrs.

E - Expert Over 35 yrs. Riders who have competed in a open series in the past 5 years and Sharpy.

D - Clubman Over 35 yrs. Riders who only compete in club champs and occasional open event.

M - Masters Over 40, excludes riders who have ridden in expert class within the past 5 years.

T - Intermediate 16 – U18yrs Note-Intermediate riders are classified as seniors.

Juniors

P – Junior Up to 9yrs 50cc 2st up to 70cc 4st (non competitive - Refer Club Rules on website)

J0 – Junior 7 – U12yrs 65cc 2st (also non competition bikes up to 80cc 2 stroke/110cc 4 st)

J1 – Junior 9 – U12yrs 85cc 2/S up to 150cc 4/S STD Wheels only

J2 – Junior 12 – U16yrs 85cc 2/S up to 150cc 4/S STD & Big Wheels

J3 – Junior 13 – U16yrs 100 - 200cc 2/S

J4 - Junior 13 – U16yrs 250cc 4/S

F - Females - All Ages, all powers

Where a class is defined by age, the age is that of the competitor on 1st January 2012.

Minimum class size is 4 riders.

NO BIKES ARE TO BE STARTED BEFORE 9 AM, CAMPING TBA AND ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS, DO NOT BRING ONE.

CHECK THE CLUB WEBSITE AFTER 6 PM FRIDAY FINAL INSTRUCTIONS.

EVENT WILL NOT PROCEED IF A TOTAL FIRE BAN IS DECLARED.
